TRAINING PACKAGE #1 \$440/month

Includes: 4 lessons and/or professional rides per week / 16x month
Lunge with/without Biting Rig (in place of lesson or ride when necessary for training purposes or inclement weather)

This package reduces your lesson rate to \$27.50 each - saving you \$360 compared to individual lesson rates

TRAINING PACKAGE #2 \$345/month

Includes: 3 lessons and/or professional rides per week / 12x month
Lunge with/without Biting Rig (in place of lesson or ride when necessary for training purposes or inclement weather)

This package reduces your lesson rate to \$28.75 each - saving you \$255 compared to individual lesson rates

TRAINING PACKAGE #3 \$280/month

Includes: 2 lessons and/or professional rides per week / 8x month
Lunge with/without Biting Rig (in place of lesson or ride when necessary for training purposes or inclement weather)

This package reduces your lesson rate to \$35 each - saving you \$220 compared to individual lesson rates

TRAINING PACKAGE #4 \$160/month

Includes: 1 lesson and/or professional ride per week / 4x month
Lunge with/without Biting Rig (in place of lesson or ride when necessary for training purposes or inclement weather)

This package reduces your lesson rate to \$40 each - saving you \$50 compared to individual lesson rates

INDIVIDUAL LESSON/SCHOOL \$50/session

Individual and Package lessons are ½ hour private, 45 min semi private or 1 hour group

EXTENDED OR COMBINATION LESSON \$15 additional to package rate, per session

This is either when a 1 hour private lesson is requested, or it is necessary for the trainer to school the horse prior to or during the lesson.

All training package fees are due by the 5th of the month.

All training package fees are based on a 4 week calendar month. If calendar month allows for additional lesson or schooling sessions you will be charged a prorated fee based on your training package.

If all lessons in package #1, #2, #3 are not completed, lessons taken will be charged at the prorated amount of the next package down, and a credit given on the following months statement. If less than 4 lessons are taken, those lessons will be charge at the individual lesson/school rate of \$50, and a credit given if there is one. Clients are allows to carry over up to 1 missed lessons to the next month, but it must be taken in addition to their regular package, not in place of.

HORSE SHOWS

Schooling fees

Schooling fee covers trainer riding horse for warm-ups and/or classes.

* \$25 warm up fee will apply if rider is not competing at show and therefore no coaching fee is charged.

Additional fees that may apply

Single and multi day shows

Wrap/Load	\$15	if owner/rider not present to wrap and/or load either before or after the show
Horse Use	\$40	if using horse owned by HV, HV client, or Heartland Ranch (fee waived if leasing horse)

Multi day shows only

Day Care	\$35/day	includes feeding, watering, blanketing, stall cleaning, leg wrapping if needed
Partial Day Care	\$15/day	includes feeding, watering, blanketing - all horses must have at least partial day care
Set up/tear down	\$40/show	covers set up of stall, tack rooms, and seating area
Trainer expense	\$65/day split between # of riders at show.	Helps cover trainers expenses such as hotel, food and transportation to/from horse show other than shipping of horses for duration of show

TRAILERING

All hauling is "round trip" and per horse. Basic rate fee starts at the time the trailer is hooked up.

SUPPLEMENTS/MEDICATIONS

	<u>simple preparation</u>	<u>complicated preparation</u>
Per feeding	\$2.00	\$4.00

Simple preparation would be feeding grain/pellets. Anything requiring extra preparations such as supplements, medication, grinding or soaking, or if it must be given orally, would be considered complicated preparation.

ASSISTING VET OR FARRIER

	<u>15 minutes or less</u>	<u>15-30 minutes</u>	<u>30-45 minutes</u>
Holding horse	\$5	\$10	\$15*

For services requiring more than 45 minutes, each additional 15 minutes will be charged at a rate of \$5.

Above fees apply when trainer is asked to be present during Pre-Purchase or Soundness Exam.

WOUND/INJURY OR OTHER CARE

	<u>15 minutes or less</u>	<u>15-30 minutes</u>	<u>30-45 minutes</u>
Any care	\$5	\$10	\$15*

Examples of this would be; wound or injury care, icing or cold hosing, wrap application or any other service beyond grooming, tacking, untacking and hosing after schooling session.

For services requiring more than 45 minutes, each additional 15 minutes will be charged at a rate of \$5.

If trainer's supplies are used, extra charge will apply to cover cost of supplies.

Shot administration	\$3 per shot
	\$5 per shot if I provide the needle and syringe

SHAVING & MANE PULLING

	<u>per session</u>	
Whiskers and Bridle Path	\$5	
Legs (lower fringe trim)	\$5	
Show clipping	\$15	includes face, bridle path, legs and ears (if horse allows)
Clipper Loan	\$10 (small pair)	\$45 (large pair)
Full Body Shave	\$120	
Trace Clip	\$80	(legs and face hairy - \$20 additional for legs or face)
Mane pulling	\$15-\$25	(depending on length/thickness)

If horse requires tranquilization owner covers cost of medication.

Client is responsible for any damage incurred to clippers while on loan, cleaning and sharpening of clipper blades.

Purchasing and Outside Lease Finders Fee

For clients buying a horse or seeking a lease outside of the Hunter Valley Program, a flat fee of \$500 will apply. This fee covers time spent making inquiries to other trainers, reading ads, viewing videos and phone calls. It also covers: making arrangements to view and ride horse; setting up pre-purchase exam, helping during exam if needed, and discussing results of the exam; negotiating purchase price; and filling out all paperwork regarding final sale and insurance forms.

Additionally the fee covers discussing an appropriate training program suited to fit the needs of the client and horse, conversations regarding feed and care, and time spent fitting bridle, saddle and other equipment.

If trying horses outside of a 50 mile radius, a \$50 per diem may apply.
